

## Spring Birding Big Day

The optimal time in which to look for the birds listed below is from early May through mid June. During these weeks, these birds are likely to be present and their presence is relatively easy to detect because they are singing as they go about their nesting activities.

Many of the birds listed below could be seen at a number of different parks. This list is only a suggestion of one possible outcome of such a count. Each bird is listed only once, even though many are likely to be seen more than once. This list of 72 birds provides an idea of how one might see a wide variety of birds in spring by visiting a number of different sites.
