PRIORITIES FOR REGISTRATION

Teams missing their registration date, lose their priority.

- FIRST PRIORITY** Returning DISTRICT teams who wish to play in the same league as last year have first priority. A returning DISTRICT team is a team with no more than four players residing outside the District boundaries and whose team participated in the 2009 Willamalane Park and Recreation District summer softball league. Seven players must also be returning from last year's team.
- SECOND PRIORITY** Returning DISTRICT teams that wish to change leagues from the previous year will register second. If unsuccessful, a spot in the previous year's league will be reserved.
- THIRD PRIORITY** NEW DISTRICT teams have third priority. A NEW DISTRICT TEAM is a team with no more than four of its team members residing outside the DISTRICT.
- FOURTH PRIORITY** Any returning non-District teams.
- FIFTH PRIORITY** A new non-District team whose sponsor owns a business within the District boundaries has the fifth priority. The team is not required to meet the above stated residency qualifications.
- SIXTH PRIORITY** All new non-District teams.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

1. Find your team's priority listing as stated on the next page.
2. Find your priority registration date on page 1.
3. Fill out your team's roster by following the instructions on page 2.
4. Fill out the Softball Team Information Sheet (page 5).
5. Turn in your registration fee, team roster, and team information sheet between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. on your appointed registration date.
6. Teams not following these procedures could lose their priority for registration.

TEAM ROSTER

Leagues are open to all recreational teams. Teams classified ASA or USSSA "C" or above in 2009 are not considered recreational and are not permitted to register as a team. Only two players from 2009 ASA or USSSA "C" or above registered teams are permitted per Willamalane team. Teams found in violation of this rule will be expelled and forfeit their registration fee.

The final roster is limited to 20 players and **MUST BE TURNED IN AT REGISTRATION WITH A MINIMUM OF 10 PLAYERS LISTED.**

Rosters will not be accepted by the office staff until each player has signed his/her own name and listed address, age, and phone number. It is necessary for each player to sign (not print) his/her own name. **NO ONE ELSE CAN SIGN FOR ANOTHER PLAYER.**

In District Discount Fee: Applies to teams with four or less out-of-district players..

Team Representatives: Do not forget to fill out your contact information in the proper place at the top of the final roster.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- a) Additional or replacement players may be added to the roster throughout the season as long as they register before they participate. Players who change teams in the first half of the season must sit out two (2) games after being added to the new roster.
- b) Players may only play for one Men's B or C Doubleheader team and/or one Men's Recreational team and/or one Church team and/or one Coed team. Players found in violation of this rule will be suspended for the season. No exceptions!
- c) Priorities on entering our leagues are given to returning team members not to returning sponsors.
If a team that was in our program the previous year splits up, the priority will be given to whichever team has the most District players from the previous year's roster. If both teams have an equal number of returning District players, whichever team the team captain is on will receive priority. Any team with less than half of its' District players returning will be treated as a new team.
- d) All players must be 18 years or older. No Exceptions!

IMPORTANT DATES:

(1) The mandatory Task Force meetings are scheduled at the Community Recreation Center as follows:

All Men's leagues	Thursday, April 22, 6:00-7:30 p.m.
All Coed leagues	Thursday, April 22, 7:30-9:00 p.m.

(2) At that time, rules and regulations, team assignments, practice field reservations, and other pertinent information will be covered. Teams should have a representative present if they wish an assigned practice site.

(3) Leagues begin the week of June 6.

(4) Willamalane Umpires Tournament is tentatively scheduled for June 5.

(5) A scorekeepers clinic for new scorekeepers is scheduled for Monday, May 17 at the Community Recreation Center starting at 7 p.m. Please note all teams are responsible for providing a scorekeeper for their league games.
