



Citizen Planning Committee (CPC) for the Whilamut Natural Area of Alton Baker Park

Information Sheet

Committee Description:

The Citizen Planning Committee for the Whilamut Natural Area of Alton Baker Park was created to prepare a plan to determine the appropriate mix of passive recreational uses for the Whilamut Natural Area of Alton Baker Park. The Committee is now overseeing the implementation of the adopted plan. The Committee meets quarterly (typically January, April, July, and October). Members are expected to attend all quarterly meetings, and be active participants in at least one subcommittee. All members serve without compensation.

Membership:

The Committee is composed of 15 at-large citizen positions, ten of whom are from Eugene and five from Springfield.

Term of Appointment:

Members of this committee serve three-year terms. Members can be considered for reappointment to a second three-year term.

Application Process:

Springfield applicants may submit an application to Willamalane Park and Recreation District. The Willamalane Board of Directors appoints Springfield applicants to this committee. The current opening is for a term that officially began on July 1. The new members first CPC meeting will be in October.

An application consists of the application form and a supplemental questionnaire. Application materials may be picked up at the Willamalane Center for Sports and Recreation administration reception desk, downloaded from the Willamalane website at www.willamalane.org, faxed or sent by email in pdf format to an applicant upon request.
