Willamalane Middle School Sports Soccer Rules

FIFA Laws of the Game apply with the following modifications:

A. Substitutions

Unlimited substitutions may be made, with the consent of the referee, on any dead ball.

B. Length of Games

Two thirty (30) minute halves with a five (5) minute halftime. All regular season games are scheduled to start at 4:30 PM. NOTE: If the teams are not ready to play at the scheduled start time, the referee will start the game clock at 4:30 PM and the first half of play will be shortened accordingly.

C. Ball Size: #5 size ball. The home team shall provide

D. Team Sidelines

Teams must be on one side of the field, spectators on the opposite side.

E. Cautioned or Sent Off Participants

- 1) Referees will make a report of a cautioned player/coach to Willamalane.
- 2) There will be immediate substitution of a player receiving a yellow card.
- 3) Referees may choose not to show a card to a coach, but rather clearly inform him/her verbally what action is being taken.

F. GAME SUSPENSIONS:

Minimum that will apply.

2nd caution received in the same game – Ejection + 1 game

Serious foul play - Ejection + 1 game

Violent Conduct = Ejection + 2 games

Foul & Abusive Language = Ejection + 1 game

If an athlete's misconduct violates the Willamalane Code-of-Conduct, further disciplinary action will be taken, up to removal from the program.

G. Players Equipment

All players on the field must be attired in matching uniforms except the goalkeeper. The goalkeeper must wear a jersey that is different from the other players and the referee.

No equipment shall be worn that is dangerous to another player. (Hard and unyielding items [guards, casts, braces, etc.] on the hand, wrist, forearm, elbow, upper arm or shoulder are illegal unless covered, and must be padded with a closed-cell, slow recovery foam padding no less than 1/2-inch thick. The game official has the final say as to whether or not a cast is properly wrapped and safe for play).

Shin guards, covered by socks, are mandatory. Players not wearing shin guards will not be allowed to play.

No jewelry is permitted. Taping of jewelry is allowed if piercings cannot be removed. Medical alert and religious bracelets/necklaces are allowed, if taped.

H. Scoring Method and Tie-Breakers

There are no standings kept in this league, therefore there are no tie-breakers required.

I. Safety

In the interest of everyone's safety, please observe the following: no one may play if they are bleeding or there is blood on their uniform. The player must leave the field and may be substituted at the coach's discretion. The uniform must be changed. The player may return to the game after bleeding is stopped and the wound is covered.

- No heading, a player may not use his/her head to play the ball
- No slide-tackling, a player may not make contact with the ball while on the ground (Does not apply to the goalie)

The penalty for playing the ball using the head or slide-tackling is an indirect free kick at the spot of the infraction. If the infraction is committed by a defending player in the defender's penalty area, the free kick will be taken from a spot on the penalty area line parallel to the end line that is nearest to the spot of the infraction.

The infraction consists in intentionally playing the ball with the head. If the referee determines that the ball struck a player in the head when the player is not trying to play the ball, the referee should allow play to continue.

Concussions: A player who demonstrates signs of concussion as a result of an observed or suspected blow to the head or body must leave the field and may not return to play in that match. Referees will include in their match report information about any player required to leave the field because of a suspected concussion. A player who has been removed from a game because of a suspected concussion is ineligible to play until the Athletic Director has received a copy of a medical release signed by a health care professional that authorizes an unrestricted return to competition.

J. Officials:

There will be one (1) referee assigned for each game. The referee may choose to ask for two (2) adults to assist with out of bounds calls only. Any coach wishing to log a complaint regarding the conduct of an official should do so in writing with a copy forwarded to the Middle School Athletic Director. No coach is to contact the Referee directly.
